

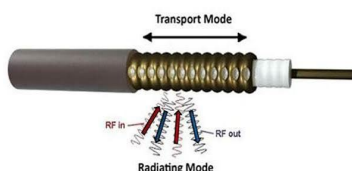

m amateur bands. There are several trophies to be won for the three contests.

The SARL HF Phone contest starts off the month of August and runs from 14:00 to 17:00 UTC on Sunday 2 August 2026. You can participate as a single operator single radio - single band station; a single operator single radio - all band station; a multi operator - single band station or a multi operator - all band station with a YL or overlay for each category. Individual competitors and club stations are encouraged to compete. The exchange is a realistic RS report and a consecutive serial number starting at 001. Each QSO counts one point; each area worked per band counts two points and each station worked on all three bands counts two points.

For the HF Phone contest there are three trophies – for the all band station who achieves the highest score, for the single band station who achieves the highest score and for the new radio amateur (October 2025 and May 2026 RAE) who achieves the highest score. Remember there are trophies for the YL and the young radio amateur who achieves the highest score in all three contests.

The New ARRL 10-Band DXCC Award

The ARRL has introduced the new 10-Band DXCC Award plaque, recognizing radio amateurs who have achieved DXCC on all ten HF amateur bands from 160 to 6 metres. The new award celebrates the accomplishment of having confirmed at least 100 DXCC entities on each of the following bands: 160, 80, 40, 30, 20, 17, 15, 12, 10 and 6 metres (excludes 60 metres). Eligibility is based on the total of QSLs reflected in your ARRL Logbook of The World® (LoTW®) account. No additional contacts are required beyond those needed to qualify for DXCC on each individual band. If your DXCC credits are not already visible in LoTW, you must first link your DXCC and LoTW profiles by requesting a credit merge from the ARRL Awards Desk.

DX from Africa

(These count towards your All Africa Award)

Namibia, V5. Gunter, DK2WH will be operating as V51WH from 25 August until 10 October from a farm near Omaruru. Operations will be from 160 to 6 metres including 60 metres. An entry in the CQ WW RTTY contest is included as V55Y. QSL via home call.

Lesotho, 7P. Wolfgang, HB9CCS will be active as 7P8EA during end October and the end of November. Operation mainly on 15 metres using CW and SSB. QSL via LoTW.

African Islands

(These unfortunately do not count towards your All Africa Award)

Seychelles, S7. Kasimir, DL2SBY will again be active as S79/DL2SBY between 11 and 21 September with operations from 80 to 6 metres using CW, SSB and digital. QSL via home call or LoTW.

Sao Tome, S9. Francisco, CT7AKS will be active as S9R with EC7R, D2ACE, CT1BOL, D2IM, CT1BZG and CT3MD between 17 and 31 October with 3 stations from 160 to 6 metres using CW, SSB and digital. <https://s9r.viacom.ao/>

Rodrigues Island, 3B9. Kazu M0CFW will once again be operating as 3B9KW during the CQ WW SSB contest (24 and 25 October) and during the CQ WW CW contest (28 and 20 November.) Operation before and after the contest as 3B9/M0CFW between 20 and 28 October and between 22 November and 2 December. QSL via LoTW.

Seychelles, S7. Rudi, OLK2ZA and David, OK6DJ will be active as S79/OL1T between 28 December and 8 January 2027. Operation on various bands and modes. More to follow. QSL via LoTW.

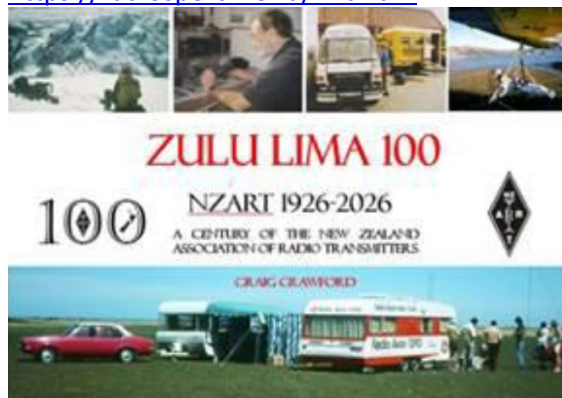
